*January 11-31, 2021*

Jesus defines our “neighbor” in Luke 10 as anyone that is in our sphere of influence and calls us to care for their needs. All of us have neighbors who are lost in sin and under the power of darkness. They are found where we live, work, play and study. They are in great need of the love of God in Jesus Christ. 1/11	Matthew 4:23 And he went throughout all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction among the people.	Help us to proclaim the gospel of the kingdom courageously to our neighbors, and may your power be displayed.
1/12	Matthew 5:13 "You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet.	Enable us to be salty and full of light so that our neighbors would "taste" and "see" Christ by our witness and works and come to glorify God.
1/13	Matthew 9:36 When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.	Help us to see our neighbors who are astray from the Great Shepherd and have compassion.
1/14	Matthew 19:13-14 Then children were brought to him that he might lay his hands on them and pray. The disciples rebuked the people, but Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven."	Would you bring children to Sojourner who don't know Christ, along with those neighbors who would receive Christ with child-like faith?
1/15	Matthew 28:18-20 And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. (19) Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, (20) teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."	Help us to obey this Great Commission. Bless our frail efforts with your mighty power and authority, that many would become your disciples, be baptized, and observe all you commanded?
1/16	Mark 12:31 The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."	Give us sincere love for our many lost neighbors we live near, work with, and play around.

<b>1/17</b>	John 1:12-13 But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, (13) who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.	We plead that our neighbors would receive Christ and believe in his name; that they might be born again and become your children.
<b>1/18</b>	John 1:39 He said to them, "Come and you will see." So they came and saw where he was staying, and they stayed with him that day, for it was about the tenth hour.	May you draw many to "come" and may you open their eyes to "see" the light of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.
<b>1/19</b>	John 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.	Thank you for your great love in sending your Son. Please grant saving faith and salvation to many of those for whom we pray.
<b>1/20</b>	John 4:13-15 Jesus said to her, "Everyone who drinks of this water will be thirsty again, (14) but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." (15) The woman said to him, "Sir, give me this water, so that I will not be thirsty or have to come here to draw water."	Please show many that their spiritual hunger and thirst can only be satisfied by your provision. May they feast upon the bread of life and drink of the living water.

<b>1/24</b>	Acts 17:16 Now while Paul was waiting for them at Athens, his spirit was provoked within him as he saw that the city was full of idols.	Help our neighbors to see the idols of their life, to seek and find You who will judge the world, and to repent and believe
<b>1/25</b>	Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.	Help us not to be ashamed of the gospel, but rather cause the gospel to work powerfully through us to save our neighbors.
<b>1/26</b>	1 Corinthians 9:22b-23 I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some. (23) I do it all for the sake of the gospel, that I may share with them in its blessings.	Give us grace to disadvantage ourselves for the advantage of our neighbor in the hope they may be saved.
<b>1/27</b>	2 Corinthians 2:12-14 When I came to Troas to preach the gospel of Christ, even though a door was opened for me in the Lord... But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere.	Open the doors into our neighbors' lives for us. Make us ever more the fragrant aroma of Christ.

<b>1/30</b>	<p>1 Thessalonians 1:8 For not only has the word of the Lord sounded forth from you in Macedonia and Achaia, but your faith in God has gone forth everywhere, so that we need not say anything.</p>	<p>May the gospel sound forth from us in such a way that our faith in you is obvious to all the neighborhoods around us and beyond.</p>
<b>1/31</b>	<p>1 Peter 3:15 but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect,</p>	<p>Help us to be prepared to give a reason for the hope we have so we may resolutely defend the gospel with gentleness and respect.</p>
