For Persecuted Christians and Civil Rulers

1. For all who are persecuted for righteousness' sake: Hebrews 13:3 *Remember those who are in prison, as though in prison with them, and those who are mistreated, since you also are in the body.*
 - Worst nations for persecution of Christians from World Watch List: North Korea (No. 1), Afghanistan (No. 2), Somalia (No. 3), Libya (No. 4), Pakistan (No. 5), Eritrea (No. 6), Sudan (No. 7), Yemen (No. 8), Iran (No. 9), India (No. 10)
2. Pray for our leaders: 1Ti 2:1-2 *First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, (2) for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.*
3. For just governance: *Give justice to the weak and the fatherless; maintain the right of the afflicted and the destitute. Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked.* (Psalm 82:3-4)
4. For the maintaining of the freedom of religion in our land so that the gospel could be obeyed here and be sent to the nations.
5. For those who serve in the armed forces: protection, Christian fellowship, stability in the midst of moves and change.
6. For peace at home and abroad.
7. That the people of God would be salt and light in a decaying and dark world. (Matt 5:23-24)
8. That the word of the Lord would sound forth and our faith in God would go forth everywhere, to the ends of the earth (c.f. 1 Thess 1:8)

1. Trey’s team at Sacred Road Mission is continuing to serve the children of the Yakama Reservation in unique ways during the pandemic, primarily through weekly care package deliveries to around 200 students!
2. The church plant Hope Fellowship has been able to hold services, youth group and continue their mobile library as state guidelines allow.
3. The team held their very first “kids club” bible study a few hours away in Idaho where several encouraging connections were made. Trey hopes to make this a weekly trip.
