## II. Equity versus Egalitarianism; Justice as equal treatment versus equal outcomes.

- a. Calls for Justice for the Poor in scriptures

- i. Leviticus 19:13 You shall not oppress your neighbor or rob him. The wages of a hired worker shall not remain with you all night until the morning.

- ii. Amos 5:24 But let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream.

- iii. Micah 6:8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?
