4. That believers in Ukraine would be upheld in faith and find their confidence in the word of God, no matter what happens.
5. That the kingdom of Jesus Christ and his gospel of grace would advance even through what has been intended for evil: that Russians and Ukrainians alike, along with many others would hear and receive the gospel of the grace of God.
